The names contained in an aging appointment book which once belonged to Jack Ruby apparently hold no special interest for New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison.

Andrew Sciambra, an investigator on Garrison's staff, said his office "has no intention of pursuing this matter at this time."

Sciambra referred to the book found by a Dallas contractor during the renovation of a nightclub which once belonged to Ruby.

"We feel the material is too old to be of value in our case," Sciambra told The Times Herald. Garrison's staff is preparing to open the trial against New Orleans businessman Clay Shaw on charges of conspiring to assassinate John F. Kennedy.

Sciambra said the existence of the name-packed book and the contractor's claim that a mystery man had tried to buy the club at five times its value had been brought to Garrison's attention.

"We can't see how this has any relevancy to our case," Sciambra said. "If it were something concrete and new, we would be interested."

The contractor, who asked to remain anonymous, said he was offered \$50,000 for the building, five times what he had paid only a short time before.

According to the contractor, an unidentified man made the offer for an outright purchase about a year ago. He also offered the same amount if the club was never reopened, the contractor said.

A search of the building turned up a false attic which was found to contain four boxes of personal papers belonging to Ruby.

Ruby, who shot down presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald five years ago before millions of television viewers, died of cancer two years ago.

The 1963 Dallas city directory and telephone directory do not contain a listing for JACK M. BRIGGS.

On 12/18/63 records of Merchants Retail Credit Association in Dallas checked by SA ROBERT J. WILKISON reflect a JACK MC GILL BRIGGS who moved to San Francisco, California, in 1952. The records reflect a JACK M. BRIGGS whose address in 1958 was 337 Hurst, Euless, Texas, employed Sivas Civil Tank Co., Fort Worth, Texas.

Reference is made to inventory list of items submitted in this investigation, which inventory is Serial 1B15 of this file. Item D53 of this inventory is a 2-page handwritten letter, unsigned, on letterhead "Jack Ruby Associates, Dallas, Texas," addressed "Dear Jail," and bearing name C. L. CRAFARD, 1312½ Commerce Street, in upper right corner. Item D54 is a small notebook containing numerous names, addresses and phone numbers.

Items D53 and D54 were forwarded to the Bureau by Dallas letter 11/28/63 captioned JACK L. RUBY (Dallas 44-1639-555). The Laboratory report (D436849AX) concerning these items was enclosed with Bulet to Dallas 12/2/63 (44-1639-1164).

Photographs of these items are being retained in the file of this investigation. This memorandum is being submitted to record the location of the photographs and the communication pertaining to these exhibits for future reference.

Reference is made to pages 40 - 48, report of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, 2/18/64, relative to allegations RUBY was in Cuba in late 1962 and early 1963, and specifically to the allegation he traveled to Cuba by air from Mexico City.

Legat, Mexico City, by communication 3/6/65, furnished information received from CIA in a memorandum dated 2/27/64, as follows:

"Information available to this office fails to confirm that subject left Mexico for Habana, or arrived in Mexico City from Habana by air anytime during 1962."

Reference pages 23 - 29, report of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, concerning efforts to identify one "DAVIS," with whom RUBY had allegedly been in contact regarding shipment of merchandise to Cuba.

The Miami Office has advised as follows:

On 3/5/64, MM [redacted]-S, true name [redacted] advised he had seen newspaper photographs of JACK LEON RUBY but had never seen him before, never had any dealings with anyone with that name and had never met him in Houston, Texas.

It is noted MM [redacted]-S is from [redacted] and Miami, Florida, and does not have any criminal record.

Miami sources and informants were contacted with negative results concerning the identity of DAVIS.

Local federal agencies advised they do not know anyone possibly identical with DAVIS.

Reference is made to page 772, report of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, 11/30/64, Dallas, and Dallas airtel 1/29/64, concerning a notation found in effects of RUBY, as follows:

"CARLOS CAMORGO (probably CAMARGO), telephone 14-9628, Mexico City."

FISHER's cousin, JAMES WILEY FISHER, all students at Sul Ross College, had been indicted on 2/21/64 for Sodomy together with several townspeople, that WESTBROOK had been released on \$2500 bond, and his address was given as Box 492, Eldorado, Texas.

The name "Arnold Westbrook" was found in the personal property of Ruby under circumstances indicating that he may have been a member of the Sovereign Club or may have attended the Carousel Club, which clubs were operated by Ruby. Dallas set forth lead UACB to interview Westbrook who is a student at Sul Ross College, Alpine, Texas. Bureau by airtel 2/27/64 instructed El Paso to conduct the interview. El Paso has advised that Westbrook recently withdrew from college as result of his indictment on 2/21/64 on charges of Sodomy involving several other students and towns people. El Paso recommended against interview as Sodomy case attracted wide publicity, in Alpine area and interview could be misinterpreted. El Paso being instructed to interview Westbrook because if it comes to the Commission's attention that his name appeared in Ruby's personal effects and he was not interviewed, they will make inquiry and there is no connection whatever between this case and any Sodomy charges which may be pending against Westbrook.

Hey Jim:

I hope you don't mind, but I have a reluctance to post this data publicly, as I feel a proprietary interest until such time as I've been able to plumb the issue further.

The evidence of a Ruby-DAP link is tenuous, based largely upon their common friend Gordon McLendon. There is some corroborative data from Ruby gunrunning reports in which Phillips may have figured. This is an area that requires much further scrutiny.

I'm FAR more confident of the Ruby-Bishop link, as it's where I did the most work about 15 years ago. I noticed in the DPD files on microfilm that the contents of Ruby's notebook, as listed by them, included the name BISHOP with a phone number beside it. As I'd only just recently searched the Ruby notebook contents in the WC volumes, I couldn't understand why BISHOP hadn't stood out to me. In going back, I noted a methodological anomaly. FBI's report for the WC of Ruby's phone book listed the numbers found in Ruby's books, with a list of pertinent subscribers. In the process, BISHOP and a few other names disappeared. But this is when my interest was REALLY PIQUED.

} Find this!

Beside the number which Ruby notated for reaching BISHOP, were listed four subscribers, all located within the Interurban Building. I soon discounted the notion that four separate subscribers shared a party line. They included a private citizen, an import-export house, an answering service and a uniform company. Surely an answering service wouldn't share a party line in the cosmopolitan Dallas of '63. The fact that four such entities all existed at the Interurban Building was of interest, in part because it smelled to me much like the generic 'office' in which BISHOP 'swore in' Veciana on Flagler in Miami.

It is perhaps just coincidence that three of the tenants seemed ripe for such 'covers:' an import-export house would allow for the clandestine traffic in contraband [guns, drugs, fill in the blank...]; an answering service is a notorious cutout for intelligence purposes [let's not forget JERay's contacts with Raoul via a New Orleans answering service, likely located at the NOLA Trade Mart]; and a uniform company would be perfect if you wanted to.... say..... BE A DALLAS POLICE OFFICER FOR A DAY!

There are OTHER anomalies in this regard. A perusal of the '63 Dallas White Pages discloses that all four names were listed, with the Interurban Building as their street address. Yet, a peek at the Coles criss-cross Directory of the period reveals that NONE of them were in the Interurban office building at that time. Consequently, I went through the Coles Directory in an attempt to locate the suite in which they may have operated in this period. I found only ONE office which didn't seem to have a phone number. It was listed to Tom Palmer, on the 5th floor, when the AGVA office was located on the 7th floor, and listed someone other than Palmer as the manager of the AGVA office, though Palmer was the AGVA official called by the WC to testify. Hrrmmmm...

Because I first came across this data about 15 years ago, and thought I must be mistaken in my interpretations [how could some schmuck in Toronto be the FIRST to see this.... bah, not possible!], went back through all the

popular literature I had on the subject, but couldn't find a reference to it. This changed with Robert Morrow's 'First Hand Knowledge.'

CAVEAT: I think Morrow is a HIGHLY disreputable and unreliable source for ANYTHING, but I try to remain open to data, regardless of source [mustn't confuse the messenger with the message, right?] Yet every so often, his written work includes something astonishing, if only because it dovetails with some completely obscure point he should have been hard pressed to know. So, imagine my surprise when Morrow described how Agency contract killer John O'Hare [a pseudonym, possibly for Col. William Bishop] had in his phonebook the name BISHOP with a number at the AGVA offices in the Interurban Building. Was the phone located IN the AGVA offices, or was it in the suite on the 5th Floor rented to Tom Palmer, nominal official with AGVA in Dallas? Either way, Morrow reported a variant of something I had myself discovered, but hadn't seen referenced ANYWHERE else. Hmmmm... [It is also somewhat troubling to me that the Interurban Building contained the Dallas Transit offices and terminal. What wonderful access in the event that somebody wanted to..... say PROCURE A BUS TRANSFER FROM A SPECIFIC ROUTE. But I digress...]

[I should point out that the FBI report of Ruby's book, referenced above, may NOT be the only such report included in the WC volumes. As you know, without an index [which didn't exist at the time of my 'discovery'], the volumes are impossible to search in a systematic way, unless you search all 26 volumes each time you seek something. Later, I relied upon the Meagher/Snyder [?] index, but still could find only the one FBI report. Consequently, I don't want to state this definitively, but I think it's highly likely that the difference in methodology between DPD and FBI in itemizing Ruby's notebook contents was designed to flush some names out of the public record, as occurred with BISHOP. DPD files, as you know, were not included in their entirety by the WC.

I don't know if you caught it, but I listed a shopping list of subjects and persons of interest to me on this forum some time ago. The Interurban Building, McLendon, Bishop, Phillips, etc., were on the list, but I got very little of value in answer to my queries. If you develop ANYTHING on Phillips/Bishop, I'd be most appreciative. I have a couple of hypotheses re: these [this] two [one] that I think will paint them/him as far more clever and duplicitous than even WE ever thought possible. I think I've caught Phillips using a persona [for which he had true ID] that even the Agency didn't know about, and that this ID had been obtained by Phillips during the war. Recall that BISHOP carried a Belgian passport in the name Frigault. Now bear in mind that when a downed Allied pilot was smuggled out of Nazi territory by French resistance [as the escapee Phillips had been], they were supplied with Belgian papers in the event that they were stopped for questioning by the Nazis. I think Phillips kept, and regularly renewed, his WW2 Belgian ID. What a handy asset for an operator such as he. And even The Agency didn't have to know about it.

Hope this helps. ANYTHING on Phillips/Bishop is gratefully encouraged. I'll also provide you with a list of docs that I'd like to procure, as per your most kind recent offer, in the coming days. [I've just moved offices and it's a nightmare.]

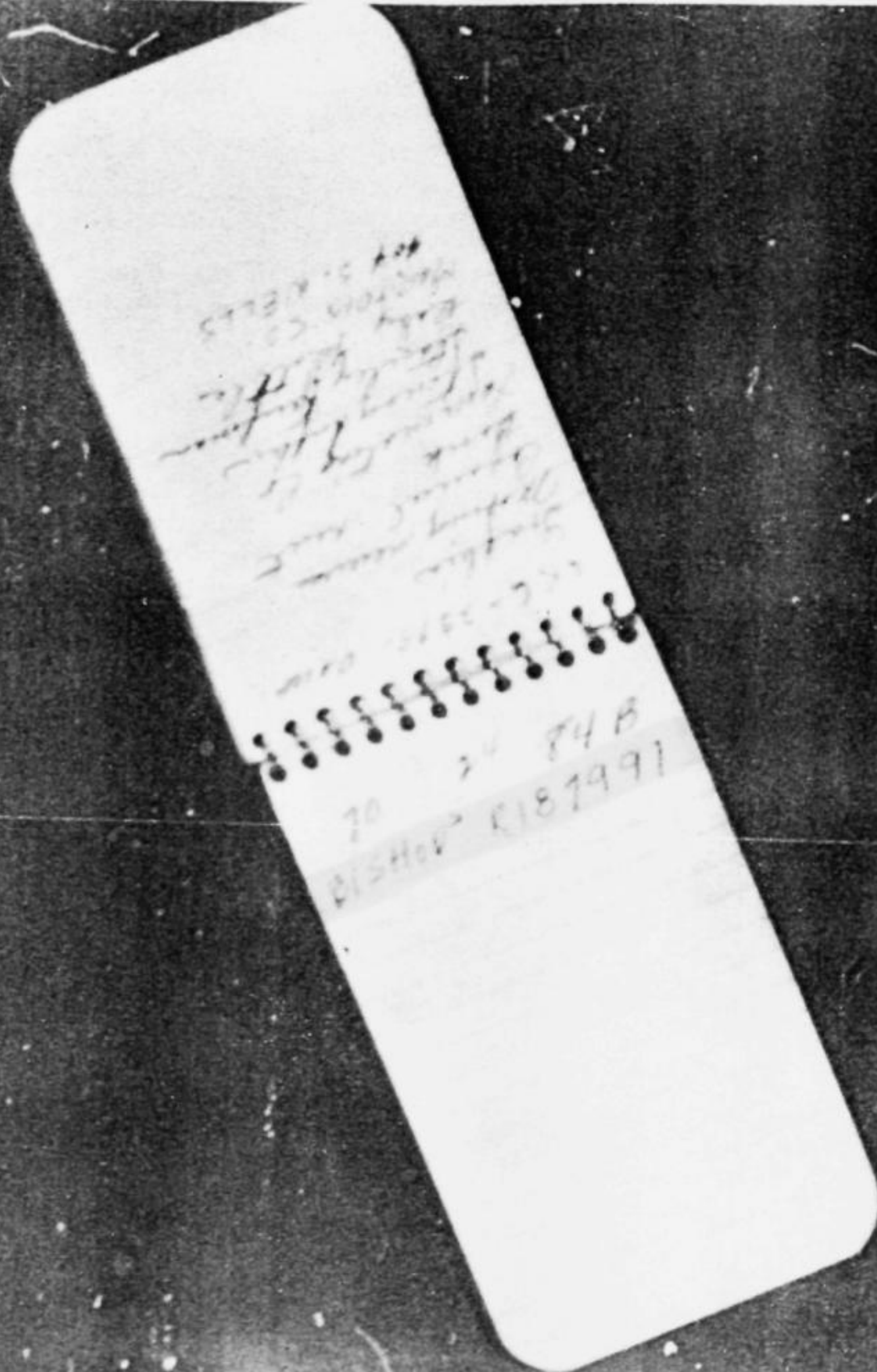

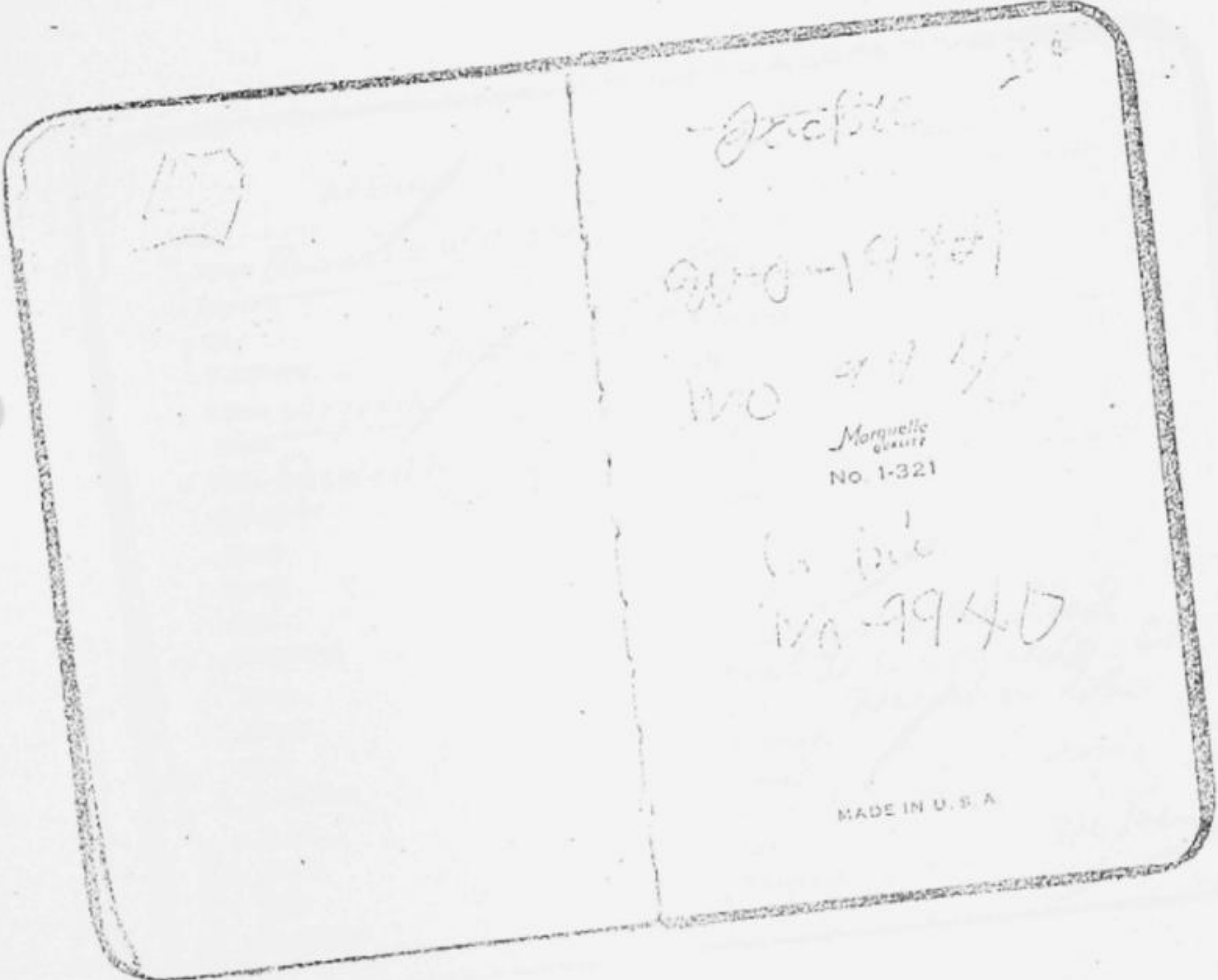

This information is being furnished to the Bureau and Dallas by Los Angeles as Agents in the Los Angeles Division cannot decide whether or not there are any significant names in this material. It should be noted that a cardboard box of material was furnished. This material was reviewed by SA's LANFORD L. BLANTON and FRANCIS G. KAHL and most of it was found to be old business records. Nothing in any of this material gave any indication of contacts or connections with LEE HARVEY OSWALD or the HUNT family.

At the time they found various business records and what appeared to be personal address books belonging to JACK RUBY the former owner of the Club Vegas. DOUTHIT further advised that she recently read an article in a collector's magazine in which a signature of LEE HARVEY OSWALD was being offered for sale for \$2,000.00. She further advised that she planned to offer for sale the various signatures on records she had found at the Club Vegas. She stated that prior to offering these records for sale she wanted the FBI to review them so that she would not later be accused of withholding or destroying evidence. She advised she and her husband left the Dallas area in June of 1967, when he was transferred to the Santa Fe Springs office of the Mobile Oil Company where he was employed as a Geophysicist. At that time they brought the records with them to the California area and they have been in storage ever since. She advised that while the records were in her possession they were never reviewed by either the Dallas Police Department, the FBI, or any other governmental agency or commission.
